## FASSBIND LES VIEILLES

**OLD CHERRY** 

This noble, carefully distilled and matured fruit brandy is made from ripe Swiss cherries. The Rigi region is famous for its tasty cherries and the cherry brandy obtained from the fruit.

Immediately after the harvest, the fresh fruit is delivered to us and mashed immediately. After the fermentation is complete, we distil the fully ripe cherries together with their fruit stones, which produce the typical almond note and aroma for the Kirsch.

The freshly distilled Kirsch first rests in stainless steel tanks for at least two years and then ripens in oak casks for 14 to 18 months. After the maturation process, the Kirsch brandy is further refined with a home-made bonficateur to enhance the wonderful aroma and subtle sweetness, which makes this Vieux Kirsch so unique.

Colour Brilliant Gold.

Nose Notes of marzipan, cherry cake and dried fruit

with a hint of Caribbean rum. Reminiscent of freshly prepared elderflower syrup with a

touch of lemon.

Palate Aromas of pickled cherries, orange-chocolate

biscuits and a hint of roasted almonds.

**Finish** Long-lasting, delicate and aromatic.

Edelweiss / beautiful, strictly protected alpine flower with white felt petals / emblem of the Swiss Alps / also called the «immortal».
